The Domain Redemption Form is used to recover a domain from the registry's Redemption period.

Recovering a domain from redemption will restore the domain to an Active or OK status and extend the domain registration period by 1 year. There are administrative fees applied by the registry, these fee's include restoring the domain and its renewal for 1 year.

Payment of the amount specified in this form apply to cover costs incurred from the registry.

If you do not wish to complete restoration of your domain it will be purged from the registry 35 days after the commencement of the restoration period.

If you would like to proceed with domain redemption, please complete ALL fields below and return by email or post.

Please note that while Domains4Less will make every effort to complete domain redemption within the registry grace period, submission does not guarantee redemption as it is subject to certain time constraints and registry approval.
